Big Red is made of steel, approximately 6 feet tall, 3 ½ feet wide, and weighs nearly 400lbs.! Big Red was donated in loving memory of the late Jodi Sue Kayser, a 1990 graduate of Minford High School.

Proceeds for Big Red were raised during the 2010 JSK Memorial Golf Tournament that was held July 10 at Big Beaver Creek Golf Course.
