The Community Action Organization (CAO) of Scioto County announces the sponsorship of the Summer Youth Feeding Program.

CAO will be providing meals to drop sites throughout Scioto County. Families may drive-thru and pick-up meals for children under the age of 18 or up to 21 with disability. Five days of Lunch and breakfast will be provided at most sites, exceptions listed below. No congregating at sites will be permitted. Families should stay in their vehicle and provide the number of children to site attendant. Sites will be open for 30 minutes.
